Dr. Annie Léger earned her degree in 1991 from Université de Sherbrooke, and has been a general practitioner at the Centre de santé et de services sociaux (CSSS) of Rouyn-Noranda in Abitibi-Témiscamingue for the past 19 years. She has a diversified practice that includes admitting privileges, obstetrics, emergency medicine and private practice patient follow-up. Dr. Léger has always been very involved in medical recruitment and in various medico-administrative committees common to acute care hospitals.

After being appointed director of professional services (DPS) at the CSSS of Rouyn-Noranda in December 2000, she maintained her clinical activities until April 2003, and has since assumed the position on a full-time basis.

From 2005 to 2010, Dr. Léger was DPS at the CSSS des Aurores Boréales in La Sarre, and from 2006 to 2013 she was DPS at the CSSS of Témiscamingue. She has been DPS at the CISSS in Abitibi-Témiscamingue since April 2015.

Finally, Dr. Léger has been a medical examiner since 2002 at the CSSS of Rouyn-Noranda. She is also board member of the Association des conseils des médecins, dentistes et pharmaciens du Québec (ACMDPQ).

Through her administrative work, Dr. Léger contributes to enhancing service quality and accessibility for the population base of the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) of Abitibi-Témiscamingue.
